



Headline Data Summary 2023

In **ALL** statutory assessment measures in Early Years, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2, Exceed Learning Partnership Trust is **ABOVE** in both national and local standards in 2023. This is true for both expected standard and the higher, greater depth standard.

Within this summary, the data has been broken down to show the percentage of pupils who have achieved the expected and greater depth standard for reading, writing and mathematics.

Further analysis shows that several of our academies are significantly above this national level and therefore in the top 20% of schools across the country.

Attainment in Phonics: One of the academies is significantly above national and 84th percentile in year 1 phonics expected standard.

These results indicate that the percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard by the end of year 2 is above national and local levels for reading, writing and maths.



For writing, 2 of our academies are significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

For mathematics, one academy is significantly **above national** and in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

These results indicate that the percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard by the end of year 6 is above national and local levels for reading, writing and maths.

For reading, 2 of our academies are significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

For writing, 2 of our academies is significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

For maths, 3 of our academies is significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

**End of Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessments, Greater Depth Level:**

These results indicate that the percentage of pupils achieving the higher, greater depth standard by the end of year 6 is above or in line with national benchmarks and above local levels for reading, writing and maths.

For reading, 1 of our academies is significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

For writing, 1 of our academies is significantly **above national** and are in the **highest 20%** of schools in the country.

For 2022, the progress data has been calculated for all 8 academies as well as for the 4 academies who have been in the Trust for 3 or more years. *(It is important to note that performance data tables from the DfE only include schools who have been in the Trust for 3 or more years and so it is beneficial to look at the data in this way also.)*

The data has then been highlighted to compare the progress with the national picture.

For reading progress, 2 schools are significantly **above national** and are in the top 20% in the country.

For writing progress, 2 schools are significantly **above national** and are in the top 20% in the country.

For mathematics progress, 1 school are significantly **above national** and are in the top 20% in the country.
